

# RSNA Derek Harwood-Nash International Fellowship

This program recognizes that there are instances when the educational needs of an international institution are best served by having an individual faculty member study at a North American institution. The fellowship period is six to twelve weeks in duration.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Candidates must:

- be promising international radiology scholars who have completed their radiology training no more than 10 years prior to application;
- be embarking on a career in academic radiology (i.e. have held a faculty position for 3 to 10 years);
- demonstrate that their specific educational goals can be met most appropriately by a course of study in a North American institution.
- specify how the knowledge and experience gained from this fellowship will benefit and improve the practice of radiology in both the home institution and the radiological community; and
- be proficient in English

The application form includes a roster of appropriate North American host academic centers where fellows may observe procedures and participate in conferences relating to their areas of special interest. The RSNA will provide a stipend of up to \$10,000 toward travel, modest living expenses, and educational materials for the 6- to 12-week fellowship period.
